TASTING NOTES Hints of honeysuckle, apricot, and peaches form a bright counterpoint to the crisp acidity and citrus aromas in this Rosé of Pinot Noir. The structure and mouthfeel of this delicate wine exhibit a pleasant weight and smooth finish.

VINEYARD NOTES Bacus Vineyards grapes are organically grown. We encourage sustainability through limited tillage and use of in row cover crops. The vineyard is on a geologic outcropping in the Chehalem Mountains AVA foothills of marine sedimentary soil that dates back to the Eocene. The vineyard was planted with north to south row orientation to maximize sunlight exposure on the canopy.
