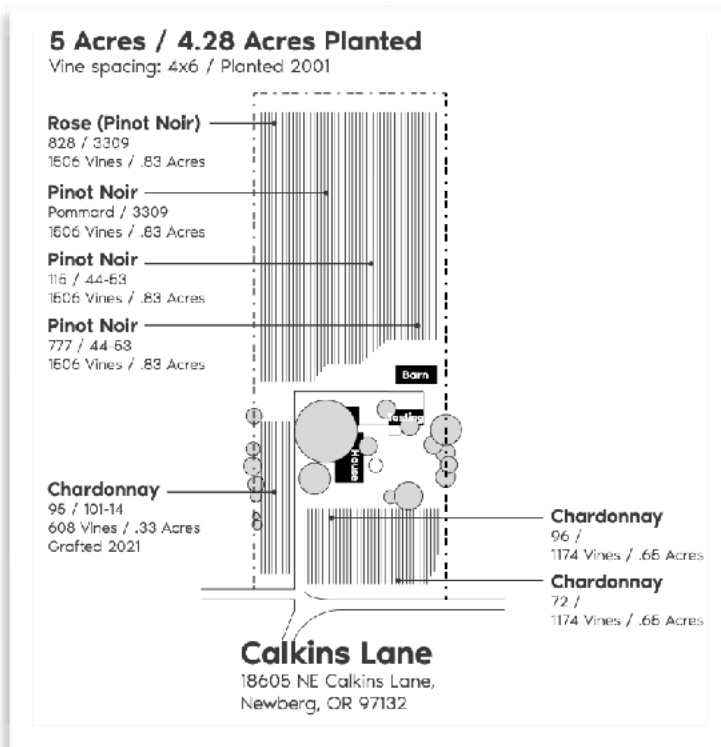


2022 WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT NOIR

TASTING NOTES (Not Yet Rated): This is a smooth, easy sipper with a nice aromatic one-two punch of black cherry cranberry and vanilla cream. It's aromas and texture consist of a tangy bramble berry mix, earth and a touch of thyme, tannins and acidity are pleasantly soft.

VINEYARD NOTES Our estate grapes are organically farmed and we encourage sustainability through limited tillage and use of in row cover crops. Our estate vineyard is on a geologic outcropping in the Chehalem Mountains AVA foothills of marine sedimentary soil that dates back to the Eocene. The vineyard was planted with north to south row orientation to maximize canopy sunlight exposure.
